Dear Parents of Year 11 students,

I just wanted to let you know about the new Maths revision website which has been set up in preparation for this year's mocks. As you may know, the Maths GCSE is changing this academic year and will, in particular, involve a greater emphasis on combining topics and problem solving. In order to give students a chance to practice these types of questions, a revision site has been shared with all of Year 11 which will release a practice exam paper every week until the mocks. The papers are made up of questions which focus on the applications of maths and cover a range of topics. These papers can either be printed off or students can complete them on paper or in their exercise books. The markscheme for each paper will become available the following week, along with the next paper.

Once a paper has been released it will remain on the site, so it won't matter if a student doesn't complete a particular week's paper in the specified time as they can always have a go later. It is also important to note that the practice papers are based on the whole GCSE syllabus - as there are some topics which will not be studied in lessons until after Christmas, there may be questions which your son does not yet know how to tackle, however the papers are still the best practice which any student can undertake in preparation for the mock exams.
