We will be holding our annual Oxbridge evening specifically for Year 10 and 11 students on Thursday 20th April at 7.00pm.

Oxford and Cambridge universities offer a unique opportunity to study with world leading academics in historic surroundings. As a consequence, their selection process is designed to select students who are both academically gifted and who will thrive in such an environment.

At Judd our students strongly represent the sort of person who will be successful in those surroundings and over the past few years we have seen our applications to both Oxford and Cambridge grow.

We believe that by encouraging students to think as early as possible about what would be required for a competitive application they will be even better prepared for the rigors of the application process. To help our students understand more about what would be involved we have invited representatives from St Hugh's College Oxford and Queens' College Cambridge to give presentations on life at both universities and why this is an opportunity worth working for.
