## Summer Examinations for Years 11 & 13

The summer examination period is fast approaching and planning for revision will be a priority for students. The timetable for all public examinations can be found on the school website in the **Our School/Exams section**. All students should have received by email, their individual default timetables. The final timetable with resolved exam clashes, venue and seating will be emailed by the start of the summer term.

Examinations start at either 9.00am or 2.00pm. Students must ensure they arrive at least 15 minutes before the start of their examination. If you are unwell, experience significant difficulties or travel problems on the day of an examination, please contact the school office immediately.

We have made the following arrangements for each year group.

### Current Year 11

Year 11 will attend lessons up to and including **Friday 28 April 2017**. The first GCSE examination is on **Tuesday 2nd May**. Year 11 students should return to school on the afternoon of **Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> June for book return and their Judd student Sixth Form Induction**. On **Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June** Judd internal and new students will have their subject induction. More details of this will be emailed nearer the time.

### Current Year 13

Year 13 students are expected to attend lessons up until **Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> May**. The 24<sup>th</sup> May will be their final day of school and will be based around an event hosted at Vizards (students who have an examination that morning will not miss out). Prizewinners and parents are invited to school for Senior Prize Giving (Skinners Day) **2.30-5pm** on **Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> June**. The final A Level examination is on **Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> June**. Year 13 students are invited to return to school for their Leavers' Assembly and tea with staff on the Headmaster's Lawn on **Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> July 1.30-4.30pm** (Text book return will also take place on this day). Some Year 13 students will be taking a re-sit of an AS examination whilst they are still in lessons during May.

Sixth Form students are expected to continue to adhere to the Dress Code.
